Raised in the small Canadian town of Lac La Hache, British Columbia, Lochlyn Munro – like any Canadian kid – had dreams of playing professional hockey, but when an injury sidelined him at the age of 18 he turned to his other passion; music, and moved to Vancouver, B.C. in 1984.

As a versatile musician, Munro played guitar, drums and performed as a singer around the city – becoming entrenched in the local arts scene – when a happenstance connection led him to audition for a new T.V. series starring a young actor named Johnny Depp. The show was 21 Jump Street, and Vancouver's film & television production industry was about to take off.

Munro soon landed one of the leading roles on the popular CBC television high school drama Northwood, and worked steadily in an array of roles through the early 1990s before moving to Los Angeles and making a mark for himself in feature films like Dead Man On Campus, Night at the Roxbury, Scary Movie and White Chicks. His talent, professionalism and adaptability, over the past 28 years, has helped to establish Munro as one of Canada's, and the industry's, most successful actors working today.
