Travel Distances from Other Major Cities

- ✓ 1.5-Hour Flight from Vancouver

- √ 1-Hour Drive from Banff

- ✓ 3-Hour Drive from Edmonton

Time-Zone Difference

✓ Toronto: +2 Hours

✓ Vancouver: -1 Hour

Climate

- ✓ The average temperature in summer is 15.2°C but there are some days with temperatures over 30°C. It is warm during the day but it gets chilly in the evening so you are encouraged to bring a sweater or jacket with you.
- ✓ You may see snow any time between September and May.
- ✓ There are some days with temperatures below -20℃ between November and February.

 Make sure to have the winter clothing such as a pair of gloves, a knit cap, a scarf, and a thick jacket or coat.
- ✓ There is unique aspect of Calgary weather Chinook. In winter, a strong Chinook wind can increase the temperature by 20°C in a few hours. Calgary can have very cold winter weather, but throughout the winter, the daily high temperature is usually just a degree or two below freezing. Every house has central heating system.
- ✓ Calgary has a dry climate and has more days of sunshine per year than any other Canadian city.

Transportation

The main transportation facilities are buses and LRT called "C-Train". They are run by the federalize company called "Calgary Transit".
